



ADDENDUM TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

between

GRIFFITH UNIVERSITY

and

NATIONAL ECONOMICS UNIVERSITY

Griffith University, Brisbane, Australia ("Griffith") and National Economics University, Hanoi, Vietnam, ("NEU") signed a Memorandum of Agreement on the 3 December, 2018.

Both parties wish to amend the Memorandum of Agreement with the following provisions:

AMENDMENT 1: THE PROGRAMS

This agreement is for students articulating into the Bachelor of International Tourism and Hotel Management degree program.

SPECIFIC ADMISSIONS COOPERATION

The selection and admission of students into the Griffith Programs is the responsibility of Griffith.

The Articulation and Credit Transfer arrangements for entry into the current Griffith Programs are detailed in the Articulation Schedule attached to this agreement. Additional programs may be added and amendments made to these programs through the appropriate authority at each institution. Full details of Articulation and Credit Transfer arrangements between the institutions are available at <u>Credit transfer for Overseas Institutions</u>. The website contains the most up–to–date information on these articulation arrangements and takes precedence over the content of the attached Articulation Schedule in the case of a discrepancy.

AMENDMENT 3: DIRECT ENTRY TO GRIFFITH BUSINESS SCHOOL MASTER PROGRAMS FOR NEU BACHELOR DEGREE GRADUATES

Students who graduate with a NEU bachelor degree with a minimum GPA of 4.0 (using a 7 point scale) will meet the academic entry requirements for Griffith University's:

- Master of Business, (5632)
- Master of Finance, (5592)
- Master of Financial Technology, (5746)
- Master of International Tourism and Hospitality Management, (5709).

Griffith's academic entry requirements are subject to review. The Griffith website contains the most up to date information on entry requirements to the above programs and is available at the degree and career finder https://www.griffith.edu.au/study/degrees

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

At the time of signing this agreement, the English language entry requirement for NEU students enrolling in the above Masters programs at Griffith must reach the minimum overall band score 6.5 IELTS (Academic) with no sub-score less than 6.0, or equivalent.

NEU students who do not meet the English language entry requirements may apply to enrol in the Direct Entry Program (DEP) conducted by Griffith English Language Institute (GELI). Upon successful completion of DEP, students will have met the English language proficiency requirement to enter their program of study directly, without needing to sit an external proficiency test.
